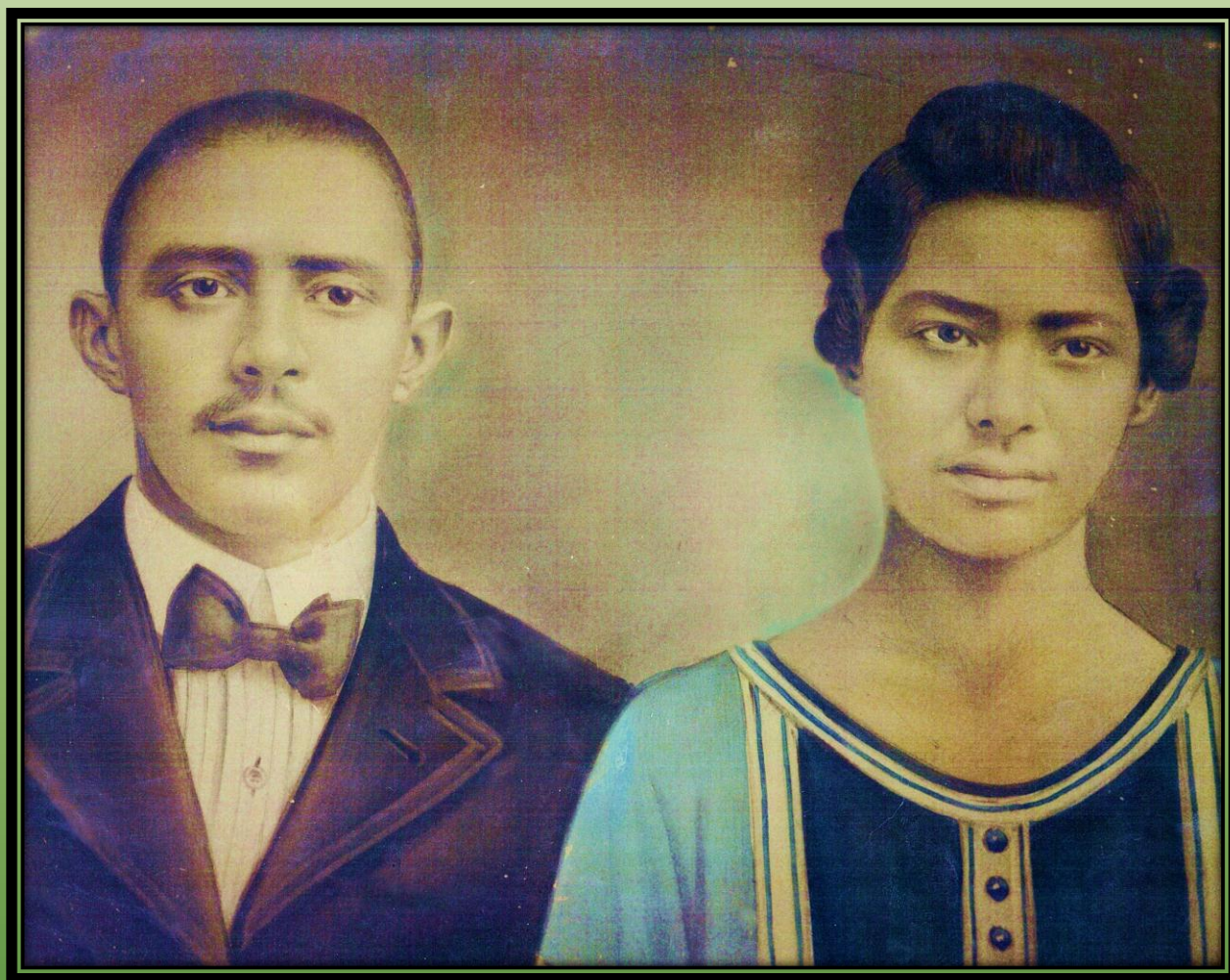

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PREFACE

This book is a second in a series of three books to be published of my combined families during the year 2012. The first book: THE BOTHWELL FAMILY OF ASHVILLE, AL AN UNOFFICIAL GENEALOGY – Descendants of Jesse & Narcissus Bothwell is a history of my paternal family. The third will be a complete history of my maternal family – The Montgomery Family of Ashville, AL.

This book is specifically limited to my maternal grandparents, Joe and Auttie Montgomery.

It has taken extreme patience and perseverance to pull this extensive amount of information together in a short window of time. I apologize to the many family members that I have pressed for information; however, I truly wanted as complete a project as possible. To that end, I would also like to say that an end date for publication had to be established in order to meet the scheduled reunion date of July 20 – 21, 2012. Thus, there are a number of known family names that are missing and some pictures are copies from 1998 suggesting that at one point we did have the originals.

I especially enjoyed pulling this book together, because as I did came the realization that my first effort at pulling together family information and pictures dates back to 1986. During the family reunion that year we took group family pictures. Following that reunion I assembled the family pictures, names, addresses and other information into a personal family album. My next attempt to complete family genealogy occurred in 1998 when a more extensive booklet was created that included dates of birth, addresses and other information.

I think you will find the inclusion of more in depth family history and genealogy very rewarding and heart-warming. The level of documentation and breath of the history is richer than we've ever uncovered previously. The introduction of the "Mize" family name for Rachel and additional stories about Joe and Auttie's lives were an intrigue for me and I believe will be for you as well.

My greatest hope is that in years to come the family will have a great respect and appreciation for this work and the efforts put forth in producing it.

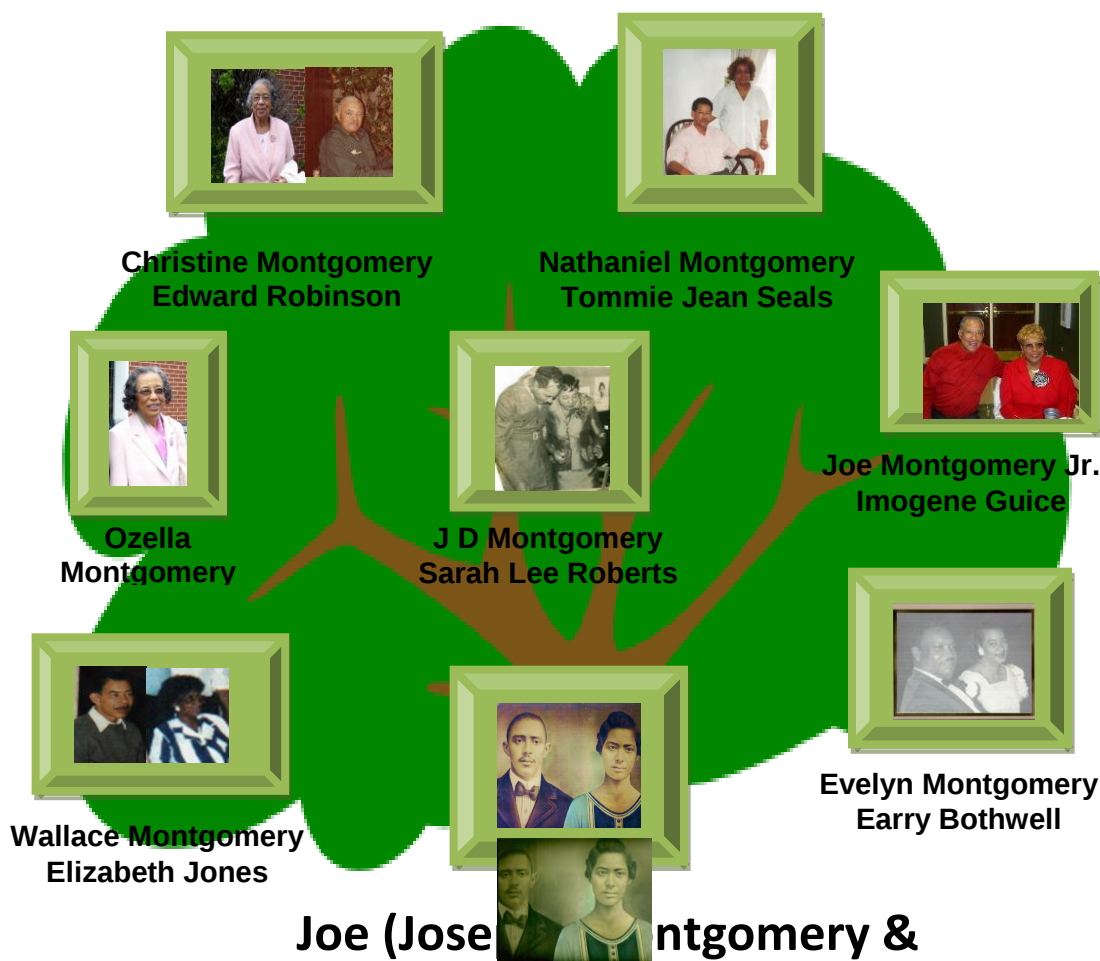

FAMILY HISTORY

MONTGOMERY FAMILY HISTORY



Our Montgomery family history can be traced with certainty back to Ashville, St. Clair County, AL as early as the birth of Jane Mize in about 1841 and her husband Daniel Mize born in about 1842. This is documented through the 1870 US Census. Daniel and Jane Mize were both shown as having been born in Alabama. This likely means both Daniel and Jane were born as slaves. Daniel's race was shown as Black and Jane's as Mulatto, which generally meant Jane was of mixed race. D. Mize and his family also appear in the 1966 Slave Schedules.

Included in the 1870 US Census was an older daughter, Rachel, who was fourteen (14) years old at the time and her race was listed as Mulatto as well. Thus Rachel was born in about 1856, also during slavery. There were three additional siblings listed: Josephine, age eight; Willie, age four and John M., age five months. We have not been able to uncover any additional information about the Mize family beyond Rachel at this point. We were able to obtain Rachel's parent's names from her death record obtained from Alabama Deaths and Burials Index, 1881 – 1974. In addition the name Rachel Mize shows up on her third husband's death record and on a couple of her children's death records as well. In discussion with the Alabama State Archives reference archivist, a word of caution that this simply places Rachel in the home, does not definitively establishes both Daniel and Jane as Rachel's parents.

You will note in some previous documented family history that Rachel's maiden name was shown as Truss. Also, at the time of Rachel's first marriage to Pope Montgomery her name was shown as Rachel Truss. It is believed that the Truss family out of Anniston was the slave owners for Rachel. It was reported that earlier visits to the Ashville Archives by Barbara Lawrence Green and Bernice Bradford Fomby uncovered a Truss family *will* that showed Rachel as a family slave. This is still under research at the time of this writing by the Ashville Archives.

Rachel married Pope Montgomery November 9, 1871. *(We have been able to locate copies of marriage certificates for all three of Rachel's marriages from the Ashville Archives).* Note that after obtaining a copy of the marriage certificate for Rachel and Pok that the copies are so light and washed out that it is virtually impossible to decipher her last name. The Truss name does appear on the typed list of Black Marriages and it is assumed that the original list reflected more clearly the name Truss. Another name for Pope is Pok as it appears on their marriage record or Polk as it appears on his death record. Pope Montgomery was born in about 1851. 1880 US Census shows that he was born in Alabama, however his father was born in South Carolina and his race was Black. At this point we have not been able to uncover any additional information about Pope Montgomery's origin or family background.

During the time period 1871 – 1881 Pope and Rachel had five children: Joseph (Joe) Deed, Lola or Lorah, Edna, Janie and James P. (Punk). Pope died December 23, 1884 at the age of 33.

I do want to add a couple of caveats here. First, I have spent a considerable amount of time cross referencing and validating the information included here; either via Census records, death records, marriage records, the Ashville Archives and in person with various family members. In addition, after attending a genealogy workshop in Odenville, put on by their genealogy society, I had the opportunity to submit the copy of Pok and Rachel's marriage record and referenced the book it was recorded from and the micro fiche numbers supplied by Charlene Simpson of the Ashville Archives to the State of Alabama Archives, Nancy Dupree. After extensive effort, Nancy also was unable to decipher the last name shown on the marriage record.

Secondly, the information from the Ancestry.com system is subject to some error as it is electronically reading manually written schedules and/or micro fiches from over one-hundred and sixty years ago in some instances. Finally, the census records also recorded that most of the respondents back then could neither read nor write. So, the census takers were in some instances handicapped by their interpretation of what they were being told especially as regards to spelling of names. You'll note instances later for instance where our grandmother's name in some places was "Auttie" and in others "Auddie". However, our aunts assure me that it was Auttie. Also, our grandfather, great-grandfather and Uncle Joe Jr.'s names appear early on as Joseph and not Joe. Later the name was shortened to Joe. Our great-grandfather Joseph Deed Montgomery was known to family as Deed, however, again, early census records record it as Joseph Deed.

Rachel next marries N (also known as Nels) Bradford on December 29, 1885. There is also no information on Nels's or N's family background. The name Nels was obtained from a copy of Pink Bradford's death record. Rachel and Nels had two children: Pink (Id or Ed), a son and Icey, a daughter.

Rachel next marries Lum Baker on December 18, 1895. Rachel and Lum Baker had two children as well: Lena Bell Baker and Lennie Baker. Rachel died January 30, 1941 in Ashville, AL and Lum died November 30, 1958 in Attalla, AL.

ORIGIN OF THE MONTGOMERY NAME

Unlike with my research of the Bothwell family name, we do not have a definitive link to any other Montgomery family, though US Census records do state that Pope was born in Alabama and his father in South Carolina. There are a number of other white Montgomery families in Ashville, including those with the names of James Pendleton Montgomery, but we have not been able to link the black Montgomery's to any other family in St. Clair County at this point.

So I offer a definition of the origin of the name obtained from the internet:

This is one of the most distinguished Anglo-Scottish surnames. It is of French locational origin from the ancient castle of Saint Foi de Montgomery in the diocese of Lisieux, Normandy, or from St. Germain de Montgomery in Calvados. The name is first recorded in England in the latter half of the 11th Century. Roger de Montgomery, a Norman nobleman who took part in planning the Invasion of England in 1066, was created Earl of Arundel and granted vast estates in Sussex circa 1067. He obtained the earldom of Shrewsbury in Shropshire in 1071. The former county of Montgomeryshire in Wales received its name from the Norman territory, the component elements being the Old French "mont", a hill, plus the Germanic personal name "Gumaric", meaning "man-power". Robert de Mundegumri was the first recorded namebearer in Scotland, a charter witness in circa 1165. The Montgomeries were granted the earldom of Eglington in 1507. Sir Bernard Montgomery, the British Field Marshall of the Second World War, was arguably the most successful army commander since the days of the Duke of Wellington in 1815. The first recorded spelling of the family name is shown to be that of Hugo de Montgomeri. This was dated 1086, in the Domesday Book of Staffordshire, during the reign of King William 1st of England, and known as "The Conqueror", 1066 - 1087. Throughout the centuries, surnames in every country have continued to "develop" often leading to astonishing variants of the original spelling.

DESCENDANTS OF JOSEPH (JOE) AND AUTTIE MONTGOMERY

Joseph Montgomery (here after referred to as Joe Montgomery) was the son of Joseph Deed (Deed) Montgomery and Sally Moore. Deed was the oldest son of Rachel and Pope Montgomery. Deed and Sally represented the first generation born out of slavery. Joe was born December 15, 1896 in Ashville, AL. Joe married Auttie Byers, daughter of Henry Byers and Annie (Fannie or Sis) Petty (or Pettie) on April 17, 1916 in Ashville, AL. Auttie was born October 1895 in Beaver Creek, AL.

At the onset of Joe and Auttie's marriage they lived with Joe's Uncle James Pope Montgomery or as known to the family – Uncle Punk. Recall that Uncle Punk was brother to Deed, Joe's father. Uncle Punk was born May 5, 1881 and married Julia (Juggie) Byers who was born in 1892 and was sister to Auttie. Uncle Punk and Aunt Juggie were married April 10, 1911.

Copies of land deeds show that Uncle Punk and Aunt Juggie both became land owners of property in Ashville, St. Clair County, AL as early as 1922. Uncle Punk or J.P. was quite involved in the community and the church. He served as steward, trustee, Sunday School Superintendent and teacher of the Adult Bible Class and was also one of the ministers that came out of St. Paul United Methodist Church of Ashville. Uncle Punk also played the fiddle and entertained for events held for whites.

In May 1913 the white James P. Montgomery and his wife Clara I. Montgomery deeded land to Methodist Episcopal Church and colored school for the amount of \$10.00. The church was built in 1919 and rebuilt and finished in 1920 as recorded from the church's Consecration and Recognition Program in 1985 or 1986. The program acknowledged contributions by the Montgomery family including J. P. Montgomery who became a minister out of the church as well as contributions by Joe Montgomery and his family.

Recall that Joe and Auttie had been married in April of 1916. After moving from Uncle Punk and Aunt Juggie, Joe and Auttie lived with Bud Mostella and his wife for a time. They also lived in Alabama City, AL. World War I was during the years 1914 – 1919. A copy of Joe's *draft registration* shows that he registered for the draft June 5, 1918. The *draft registration* reflects that at the time Joe and Auttie lived in Altoona, AL and Joe worked at Gulf State Steel. Congress passed the *draft registration* March 18, 1917. There were three registrations dates during World War I. At the time of the first registration June 5, 1917, Joe would have been twenty years old and just missed the twenty-one year old requirement for the draft. The second registration was June 5, 1918 for those who had now turned twenty-one years old since June 5, 1917. World War I rapidly curtailed in 1918 and the Selective Service suspended the draft November 11, 1918. Thus, Joe avoided the draft into World War I.

Coincidentally, during 1918 there was influenza *pandemic* (the "Spanish flu"). It was unusually severe and deadly pandemic that spread across the world; between 50 and 130 million died making it one of the deadliest natural disasters in human history. Aunt Christine and Aunt Ozella says, "Grandmother Auttie was very concerned as a young mother with a small child (Uncle Wallace) being away from home she convinced Joe to return to Ashville".

At some point they moved into the unfinished home in the Hollow and Joe attempted to do a lot of the work himself. They also lived in Glen's Alley.

Joe and Auttie were the parents of seven children: Wallace, Evelyn, J.D., Ozella, Joe Jr., Christine and Nathaniel.

Joe Jr. and Ozella were born in Glen's Alley and Chris and Nate were born in the Hollow. Chris recalls when Nathaniel was born. This little boy came along and took her place as the baby of the family. She didn't understand why her mother stayed in bed. Florence Bradford and Evelyn (Tweetie, her oldest sister) wanted to go to the carnival up at the Methodist Church. They wanted to take Chris and the other kids with them. When they got there Chris got frightened by the elephants and the ladies with the brightly colored dresses and started to cry and Aunt Ozella had to take her home.

Grandmother Auttie use to take in laundry for Mr. Robinson (an attorney); Mr. Runion (mailman) and a lady lawyer. A number of the women in town worked as maids at the hotel. The stores were Bolens and McBrayer. Joe held a number of jobs after getting married. He worked in the mines. He also worked at Goodyear and the Gulf State Steel.

School was held in the Baptist Church. However, Chris started at the new school on the hill at five years old. Joe worked a very large farm as a *sharecropper for Judge Sam High*. The boys and girls helped to work the farm. Joe also hired on other men, namely Clever Bothwell my paternal grandfather, and other young men to help on the farm. They raised cotton, corn, tomatoes, cucumbers, squash, peanuts, etc. Clever Bothwell also tended land and there were two John Deere tractors that they used to plow and cultivate the land. This was a full fledged farm with chickens, cows, etc.

Judge High always encouraged Joe to keep his children in school. He would say, "Joe, don't keep those kids out of school". Judge Sam High (a state senator) owned a cotton gin uptown and had a house uptown near the cotton gin a block away from the new courthouse. This was before Chris started to school in 1937 at age 5. Judge High offered Joe to live in the home as he really liked him and Joe was working sharecropping for him.

Later the family moved back to the Hollow for a year. At some point in between they lived in a big house across the street opposite Uncle Punk and stayed there for ten years. Christ started college in January of 1950 and stayed at school. Soon after that the family moved to the red farm house off the Gadsden highway. After a period a lot of the boys went to service and/or began to take jobs off the farm and in the cities like Gadsden and other neighboring towns. This made for difficult times to get enough help to manage such a large farm. A couple of years before Auntie passed they moved back to the family home in the Hollow. Demetria was two years old, so the year would have been around 1957.

Aunt Ozella and Aunt Christine were among the first to complete college in the community of Ashville, but the first in the family. Aunt Ozella was in college from 1949 – 1954. She started at Clark College in Atlanta, but after she and Chris were at Clark for one semester together she moved on to Alabama A & M where she graduated. Aunt Christine was in college from 1950 – 1956 at Clark College. Neither of them went straight through full time because their mother was sick and the family couldn't afford it. Aunt Christine says she was so determined to go to college she wrote repeatedly to Clark College and they gave her a working scholarship to attend. They were forced to take turns going and would do semesters at a time and come home and work and help care for their mother. Uncle J. D. had attended Alabama A & M for a period a couple of years ahead of Aunt Ozella and Aunt Christine. It is believed that Uncle J.D. may have been the first African American male to graduate from Ashville Colored School in 1942. Prior to that time the school only went to the ninth grade. Students wanting to graduate high school had to travel to other cities. The family recalls that there were five girls that were the first to graduate the high school several years ahead of Uncle J.D.; among them was Jessie Lou Phillips Bradford, wife to Edward Bradford. Uncle J.D. was a very good basketball player and Uncle Nathaniel remembers his high school team going to the State Championships.

The family made the move back to the Hollow when Demetria was two years old which would have been in about 1956 - 1957. Auntie died May 6, 1957 at the age of 61.

Much like his Uncle Punk, Joe Montgomery was very active in the community and church. There is a poster in the St. Paul Methodist Church that chronicles some of his involvement:

- Throughout his life time Joe served as steward, trustee, Sunday School Superintendent and teacher of the Adult Bible Class at St. Paul United Methodist Church in Ashville, AL
- 1948 – Joe Montgomery participated as the St. Clair County Voters League was organized.
- 1956 – Joe Montgomery – Alabama Upper Florida conference of the Lutheran Church started.
- 1958 - Joe Montgomery was one of the three founders of Antioch Lutheran Church, Ashville, AL. This church was later consolidated with the St. Peter Lutheran Church in Gadsden, AL.
- 1960 – The Nation of Islam (The Black Muslims)
- 1967 – Joe Montgomery – Child Development Program of St. Clair County (Headstart) organized.
- 1972 – Joe Montgomery united with the Over Coming Holiness Church.

Joe had a brother Will and a sister Elizabeth according to 1900 US Census that apparently died at an early age as there is no mention of them after that point. Neither of Joe's sisters, Olivia or Christine had children. His sister Olivia married Eugene Nix and lived in Birmingham. They had a restaurant and ice cream shop called Tuxedo Junction. There was a restaurant on one side and an ice cream shop on the other. It was a very popular place in Birmingham. Aunt Christine tells of how Aunt Olivia was a very fine dresser and wouldn't enter the restaurant until she was fully "made-up and dressed". Joe's sister Christine married a doctor also from Birmingham.

Auttie's younger sister Fleeta married a Dean and moved to Omaha, NE. Her remaining sisters: Mary married Pink Bradford; Alta (Dank) married Henry Bothwell and of course Julia (Juggie) married our Uncle James Pope (Uncle Punk) Montgomery. Auttie had one brother, Joseph Byers.

Joe continued to work and farm until his health failed him. He remained faithful to the church and community as well. Joe died May 20, 1976.

Wallace, J.D., Joe Jr. and Nathaniel all served in the military (Please see pictures and records of their service on pages to follow). Wallace worked at the Republic Steel Plant in Gadsden as did Joe Jr. J.D. moved to Ohio and raised his family there. J.D. worked with the United States Postal System. Nathaniel moved to New York and raised his family in New York. He also worked with the US Postal System. Evelyn lived with her family in Gadsden as a housewife. Both Ozella and Christine were educators and worked in the Gadsden School System for over thirty years as elementary school teachers.

The Joe and Auttie Montgomery family has a long history of hard working, community minded, socially active, education driven, family centered and religiously grounded roots.

Joe had a relationship with Betty Bertha Byers, daughter of Jack Byers and Leola Bothwell,. This couple did not marry. Betty was born on 10 Jul 1933 in Ashville, AL and died on 5 Oct 1978 at age 45.

Joe married Imogene Guice, daughter of Booker T. Allen and Mary A. Johnson,. Imogene was born on 19 Jun 1934.

THE SUMMER OF 1969

I have so many fond memories of visiting Ashville during my childhood. One of my favorites is the summer I returned with Granddad, Uncle Joe and family after their visit with us in Ohio. Uncle Joe drove us all back to Ashville from Dayton. I was eleven years old. I still remember how scared I was that I would not be able to return home for several weeks. However, it was such a special summer for me and for the entire country. It was July 1969. Neil Armstrong walked on the moon that July. The day it happened I was with my Granddad, Aunt Ozella, Demetria and Aunt Christine in Ashville. We made a short trip to Gadsden that afternoon and had to rush to get to our seats in front of the television. An estimated 500 million people worldwide watched this event, the largest television audience for a live broadcast at that time. I remember the black and white images on the screen as Neil Armstrong made his walk.

It was a wonderful summer. I remember anticipating the smell of dinner each evening, clean linen on the clothesline by day, sitting in Uncle Wallace and Aunt Elizabeth's living room chatting with cousins as the heat subsided in the evenings, fighting with Demetria over her hour with the Dark Shadows soap and waiting impatiently through her piano practices, learning to knit, and walking the long driveway with our Granddad to get the mail. I also remember meeting one of my newest cousins that summer named Eric Neil and spending several days helping with a Head Start class as our aunts were teachers. Ashville became my second home by summer's end.

And sometime that summer, as we were on the phone with my parents, I was told I would soon have a new sibling. The exciting end to that story is that by September 21, I was no longer the only girl in a family of five boys. Another reason the summer of 1969 will always be among my fondest memories.

“Why They Called Her Tweetie”

Today is Sunday, May 13, 2012 – “MOTHER’S DAY”. The NBA Playoff games have ended for the day and my mind began to wonder as I saw the picture of my wife, Phyllis Dianne, posted on Facebook by our daughter, Yatisha Dannielle. Yatisha commented, “That beautiful lady is my mama! Happy Mother’s Day Momma!”

A year or so ago I had the opportunity to write a short story about my father, Earry Bothwell, for a project my cousin was working on. I also included that story in the recently published family history book, “The Bothwell Family of Ashville, AL An Unofficial Genealogy – Descendants of Jesse & Narcissus Bothwell. My thoughts have been to

write a similar short story about my mother, Evelyn “Tweetie” Montgomery Bothwell. Thanks Yatisha for the inspiration. Now to pull together my thoughts.....

As I write this story I’m now sixty-two years old. Death separated me from my mother physically at the age of nine years old. She was a very young thirty-nine when she passed. Losing a parent at such a young age can be traumatic for a child for a number of different reasons. But one of the things I’ve learned is that you lose the memories over time good and bad. I have been fortunate that some family members, especially aunts and uncles, have shared stories of my mother to help foster the memories and in some cases create new ones.

Unlike with the story written about my dad, this one is a stretch for me to share my pure memories. But as I think of it that’s probably not such a bad thing. I sometimes strain my memory to recall the sound of her voice as I have relayed to my Aunt Christine and to my wife, Phyllis. I know that it was soft and reassuring, yet strong and full of discipline. But is that why they called her, “Tweetie”?

Yatisha, and to you all, as you can see my mother was “beautiful” as well! Again, one of the benefits of losing her at such a young age is that she will always be cast in my memory as young and beautiful. In her final years she struggled with sickness and pain. I recall those times and her suffering, but when I look at the pictures and squint my eyes really tight to catch a glimpse of her image what I see is a mother who was loving, caring and giving. She was a mother who loved her children, especially me (I actually threw that one in for my brother and sister, Earry Jr. and Rebecca).

My brother, sister and I have this running discussion of who was my mom’s favorite. What we’ve come to realize is that we all were her favorites. She had a way of making you feel what you needed and when you needed it was the most important thing to her at the moment. I don’t ever recall feeling left out or second to anyone for her attention or affection. My first day of school was one of those times. The day before school began my father was giving me and my brother haircuts. Earry Jr. went first and then came my turn. The clippers became overheated and my dad had to stop to allow the clippers to cool. My dad left with a friend and returned to late too finish the haircut. My first day of school, I was faced with a haircut that would have embarrassed even the boldest six year old. With my mother’s assurance and big kiss I headed off to school with the confidence that it all would be fine. And it was!

Alright, I opened that door – the affection one that is. It is not as if I didn’t experience enough of it directly, but I love hearing the stories from others of just how “Sweet” my mother was. Stories from her siblings, stories from her in-laws, stories from childhood friends, stories repeated from my cousins repeated from their parents all are concurrent on that front. One of the stories my aunts share is how my mother and father supported their going to college. There were times when they drove them either to or from Atlanta to Clark College and/or just stopped by to visit. My Aunt Ozella shares how my mother was her babysitter for her daughter, Demetria, for the first couple of years after she was born. There was that same loving and giving family affection and support demonstrated in my father. What a rich heritage – love of family.

Here’s another one for you – “Tweetie was neat and very clean and kept her children clean, often changing their cloths more than once a day whenever they got dirty”, says my aunts. (Geez, I just had a flash of Oprah and the one scene in *The Color Purple*). Since mother was the oldest of three girls in the family and the second oldest child with Uncle Wallace being the oldest her position and role in the family growing up was basically to be my grandmother’s assistant. As I understand it she took her role quite seriously. My mother helped with the housecleaning, laundry and food preparation. My grandmother took in laundry for a number of the prominent white families in town. My mother helped with that work. But it wasn’t just the ability to do all of that for the sake of cleanliness, it was her loving attitude and desire to nurture and train us to do the same.

My aunt's, Ozella and Christine, share how my mother would thoroughly mop and clean the house including making the beds. Once that was done she'd tell them, "No running through the house tracking in dirt and definitely no sitting on the beds". And they knew she meant it! For all my nieces, nephews, daughter and son, does any of this sound familiar? Can't you see your Aunt Rebecca in all of this? LOL! Not that she's likely the only one you recognize here, as I'm sure you see some of these traits in yourselves. Notice I didn't include myself. LOLouder!

Apples don't fall very far from the tree. However, this is good fruit, remember.

I fondly recall the trips to Ashville over the weekends with my mother and brother and sister. She's driving now, but what an adventure for her to develop this skill. Like with many of us there was the one incident during her learning to drive when she took out the neighborhood row of mailboxes. Yes, mail boxes as they were all aligned along the side of the street in one spot. This of course was convenient for the postman, but a prime target for a novice driver.

My brother tells of stories of how my dad would keep his cars immaculate. He washed them often and always made sure my mom's car was clean for driving to church on Sunday. I don't remember this one, but my brother, Earry Jr., reports that at age nine or ten he began to help my dad keep the cars clean. An associated duty he earned was to rewash the white-side-walled tires before my dad would get home after my mother had driven over curbs.

So, why did they call her Twettie? My aunts seem to think it was a nickname given her by my grandfather, Joe Montgomery, as he did with most of the children. They believe it related to the fact that she was small as a young girl growing up.

Family meant a lot to my mother and since her mother, our grandmother Auttie, was also sick during those times we'd visit as often as we could. I can't recall a lot of specifics about those trips with her, but I do vividly remember one early evening with us all around the fireplace and the kids on the floor beneath quilts playing during which time my mother was repeatedly telling us to quiet down. Well it wasn't long before I received a swat and my feelings being hurt. I felt of course that I was innocent of the noise making. I'm not sure if it was my mother or grandmother that landed the swat, but things settled down a bit after that.

Yes, the memories are cloudy but all very warm. I recall some of my mother's days of pain. The days when her chest hurt so my father would pound on it in a desperate attempt to help ease the pain. A rather unorthodox approach I must admit, but it signals the struggles she had with obtaining some type of relief. I recall the sitz baths and her having to endure the water as hot as she could get it. But even in that pain I recall once she was sick and so was I. I was in my bed and she in hers. She called out to me to come and get in bed with her. Before long I was throwing up at the foot of her bed. But I felt the love and concern though I knew my mother was very sick herself.

I use to love to see her comb her hair....long and black with thick waves. I thought even in her everyday appearance she was beautiful. On those Sundays or special occasions seeing her put on her white starched usher's uniform for church that she looked much like an angel. You might not think it possible, but even in those winter months when the uniforms color changed to black, there was still that same beautiful angel. Then there were those Easter Sundays when she and her cousin, Mary Ford, would dress from head to toe, from hat to shoes and their hair freshly done that there was not a more beautiful mother to be found anywhere. Did I mention the nights when she and my dad and the others dressed to go out dancing? Wow, what a beauty!

My mother and older sister, Geraldine, were very crafty. I recall the matching colorful skirts they made. I also recall being in the second and third grades and my mother teaching me to make an apron for art class. In the third grade she and Gerald taught me how to embroider. That little arts and crafts project earned a prize at school and my name in the local newspaper – The Gadsden Times at age nine. Boy, were we all proud! Obviously the gift of sewing and crafts with upholstering, etc. were instilled early to me from my mom.

Those memories were contrast with the sickness and those times when she spoke of her fears of dying young. Those times though not a large part of my memories scarred me. Even though I didn't fully understand nor could I imagine at the age of eight or nine what life would be like losing my mother, it did frighten and sadden me to hear her talk that way. We lived in East Gadsden at the time and I recall one particular night when there was a conversation about the Lord and death. That was a particularly scary night for me. As I recall it was dark. Likely not very dark, but it was night and for a frightened little eight year old to be listening in on such an adult conversation was not particularly comforting. I recall going to bed that night shaken.

I also remember during that same time period one day the lady across the street yelling out for my mother to turn on the radio because someone had dedicated a song on the radio to her. It seems odd

to me now how such a single incidence would stick out in all of my memories. I recall the song was "Give Me My Flowers While I live". I remember the tears and the sadness. I remember associating that with every pain, including the visits to the seemingly dirty and odor ridden hospital rooms. Even in those times however, I remember the strength of endurance and the never ending love and desire to see her children safe and together.

I do recall my father telling us later that my mother's biggest desire was that the three of her youngest children would not be separated after her death. It would be a wish my father kept.

Let there be no misunderstanding, my greatest memories of my mother, Tweetie, are filled more with thoughts of her character, her strength, her love and her beauty as a person and her personality! So why did they call her Tweetie? I have my own thoughts. In researching the name Tweety on the internet it says that it is a play on words as it originally meant

“Sweetie”. A little uncanny since that eventually was one of the nicknames the kids in the neighborhood later gave to my father.

No one is exactly sure what my grandfather Joe had in mind when he gave my mother Evelyn that nickname. But with the strength of hindsight, I clearly know that it was because she was the absolutely sweetest and most beautiful mother any kid could have ever dreamed to have!

Happy Mother’s Day Mom –“Tweetie”!
